

Grade Seven Teacher Preparations:

- November:** Teacher preparation – Review the “Rip van Winkle” story in the binder.
- January:** **This project requires two sessions.** Draw the face in one session and paint it in another. There is a sheet on the “proportions of the human face” that can be copied and distributed to each student, there are some copied in the 7th grade file drawer. Mirrors can also be used to help the students with their self portraits. There are some in the MTM storeroom.
- February:** **This project requires two sessions.** Have the plaster cloth cut into strips and the cardboard bases cut prior to the beginning of the first session. There are styrofoam balls to use for heads and magazine pictures of people in movement in file drawer.
- March:** Teacher preparation – If you choose, you can cut pieces of white cloth to use for this project. Otherwise, use white tagboard. Cardboard can be shaped and taped by the students for different designs. There typically is leftover cardboard available in the MTM storeroom.
- April:** Teacher preparation – Students will need to bring in magazines and newspapers to class. **There is a note to be copied and distributed in the binder.**
