All children entering 3 year old pre-school must be 3 years of age by September 1, 2017.

They must be potty trained, no pull-ups will be allowed.

Health Examination Requirements / Physicals - All new students entering St. Margaret Mary School will need a physical for the 2017/2018 school year. **PHYSICALS ARE DUE NO LATER THAN THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.** If physicals are not received on the first day of school your child will be excluded from school

Birth Certificates and Baptismal Certificates are also required no later than the first day of school for NEW students

1. 3. Every family attending our school is expected to contribute their time and talent in one or more of our school and/or parish ministries.

These are significant expectations asked of all families who have children attending our Parish Catholic School. The combination of all three of these expectations constitutes our Catholic way of life, in worship, in practice, and in supporting our Church's Mission. Failure to meet these expectations may keep a family from enrollment in the school.
