Saint Margaret Mary School is accredited through the state of Illinois and the Diocese of Rockford. The teaching staff is certified through the state. Students learn to live their faith through religion classes facilitated by faith-filled teachers. Additionally, students participate in classroom and all-school prayer, monthly adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our school chapel, weekly all school masses and numerous stewardship projects reaching out to the community at large.

Classes at Saint Margaret Mary consistently score significantly above grade level on Iowa Assessments administered annually. The longer your child is enrolled with us, the higher their scores are above the average grade level.
